This 3-week class consists of 4 days of classroom training and 11 days behind-the-wheel/vehicle training, and is intended to provide basic skills for drivers. [See our website for more details](#)

TUITION: \$ 6,500.00 includes road test

DMV FEES: \$ 115.00 (IA permit & license fee)

Additional Expenses: DOT physical/drug screen, TSA HME fee (\$86.50) and DMV history (\$10). Student is responsible for these additional costs and arrangements.

Financial Aid/Sponsorship Opportunities: Job Center Network.

Military & Veterans: We accept the GI Bill.

Alaska Natives & Native Americans: Scholarships may be available through one of the recognized tribal organizations around the state.

*\$500 Deposit required to enroll in a course. Deposit will be applied to tuition. In the event of cancellation, all fees will be deducted prior to refund. See CEE catalog for details.

Prerequisites:

- Be at least 19 years of age
- Must be 21 years of age to hold a Hazardous Materials Endorsement
- Have a clean driving record (for the past 2 years)
- Provide a DMV Individual Lifetime Driver History (obtained no more than 30 days prior to training)
- Pass a DOT physical (physical is usually valid for 2 years)
- Federal Law requires medical providers to be on the National Registry to conduct DOT Medical Exams. To see if your provider is on the registry or to find one that is you can go to: <http://nrcme.fmcsa.dot.gov>
- Pass a DOT drug test (We will schedule you for this test when appropriate)
- Provide a copy of AK Driver's license (valid Class D license for a minimum of ONE year)
- Federal Law requires commercial drivers to prove they are lawful Permanent Resident or U.S. Citizen. You must have one of the required 6 legal documents with you when making transactions at DMV. This only effects your Commercial Driver License or Permit. Typical acceptable documents are U.S. Passport or Original U.S. Birth Certificate.
