

PTDI – BASIC DRIVER TRAINING



6-Week Professional Truck Driving Program:

- **Equipment:** Class A CDL, Tractor-Trailer, and Forklift
- **Certifications:** Class A CDL (Doubles, Triples, Tank, & Hazardous Materials endorsements), Forklift, First Aid/CPR and AED, DOT Regulations (49 CFR 172.704), and Professional Truck Driver Institute Certificate of Attainment.
- **Prerequisites:**
 - Minimum 19 years of age (intrastate only), Age 21 and over for (interstate license)
 - Have a clean driving record (for the past 2 years)
 - Provide a DMV full (10 year) driver history (obtained no more than 30 days prior to training)
 - Pass a DOT physical (usually valid for 2 years)
 - Pass a DOT drug test (cannot be done more than 10 days prior to training start date)
 - Provide a copy of AK Driver's license (valid Class D license for a minimum of ONE year)
 - Provide a copy of Social Security card (or verification letter from social security administration)

TUITION: \$8,200.00

FEES: \$275.00 (IA permit, license fee, books, lab, & certifications)

TSA FEE: \$86.50 (background check/fingerprinting fee) for the Hazmat Endorsement)

Room/Board/Transportation, DOT physical/drug screen, DMV history: NOT included in above costs - student is responsible for these additional costs & arrangements.
