

PTDI – BASIC DRIVER TRAINING



6-Week Professional Truck Driving Program:

- **Equipment:** Class A CDL, Tractors and Trailers, Forklift
- **Certifications:** Class A CDL, Forklift, First Aid/CPR and AED, Defensive Driving for the Professional Truck Driver, DOT Regulations (49 CFR 172.704), Doubles, Triples, Tank, Hazardous Materials, and Professional Truck Driver Institute Certificate of Attainment.
- **Prerequisites:**
 - Be at least 19 years of age
 - Have a clean driving record (for the past 2 years)
 - Provide a DMV full (10 year) driver history (obtained no more than 30 days prior to training)
 - Pass a DOT physical (usually valid for 2 years)
 - Pass a DOT drug test (cannot be done more than 10 days prior to training start date)
 - Provide a copy of AK Driver's license (valid Class D license for a minimum of ONE year)
 - Provide a copy of Social Security card (or verification letter from social security administration)

Class Dates: February 8 – March 19, 2010 / May 17 – June 25, 2010
July 19 – August 27, 2010

TUITION: \$6,000.00

FEES: \$225.00 (IA permit, road test, license fee, books, lab, & certifications)

TSA FEE: \$89.25 (background check/fingerprinting fee) must be 21 for the Hazmat Endorsement.

Room/Board/Transportation and DOT physical/drug screen: NOT included in above costs - student is responsible for these additional costs & arrangements.
